

Requirements for Taking an Airman Knowledge Test

Please ensure that you meet all of the following requirements prior to scheduling a test

These requirements are mandated by Lasergrade

Identification

**Any ID used to meet the following requirements must include:

- **The applicant's full legal name**
- **An official photograph of the applicant**
- **Applicant's date of birth**
- **Applicant's signature**
- **Applicant's physical, residential address (an FAA medical or pilot certificate can be use with a valid photo ID to meet this requirement)**

**All ID(s) are required to be valid (not expired) and have been issued within 10 years of the testing date.

Names (including middle) on all ID(s) should identically match the pilot's medical and/or pilot certificate(s). This is not a Lasergrade requirement, but an FAA requirement for taking a checkride

U.S. Citizens/Resident Alien

applicant must provide one of the following

- Driver's License issued by a U.S. state or territory
- U.S. Government Identification Card
- Passport
- U.S. Military Identification Card
- Alien Residency Card

Non – U.S. Citizen/Non-Resident Alien

applicant must provide a passport

- Passport – Primary ID

AND also provide one of the following forms of photo identification

Name on passport and second form of ID must match identically

- Driver's License issued by a state or U.S. territory.
- Government ID Card
- Military ID Card

Endorsements

- Endorsements must show the student's name exactly the same as the forms of ID being used for identification, including middle name(s).
- Endorsements must include the specific wording as follows:

"the applicant is prepared for the Private Pilot Airplane Airman Knowledge Test."

"the applicant is prepared for the Instrument Rating Airplane Airman Knowledge Test"

"the applicant is prepared for the Commercial Pilot Airplane Airman Knowledge Test"

Retesting after a failure

- Endorsements for retesting after a failure (FAR 61.49) must also use the same wording specified in the endorsement section above.
- The bottom section of the failed test report (labeled "Authorized Instructor's Statement" on the bottom 1/3 of the computer test report) must be completed and signed by the endorsing instructor and presented to the test proctor at the time of testing.
